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Tender conditions – active power losses

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1 Products

To compensate active losses in the transmission grid, Swissgrid launches a call for tender of baseload products of 1 MW. The following three products will be published on Swissgrid's tendering platform with the corresponding delivery period. The designations («alias») result from the time of call for tender (calendar week and year), followed by the product and the delivery period.

- Verluste+M KompWV_KWXX_20YY_BaseM_20YY_MM
- Verluste+Q KompWV_KWXX_20YY_BaseQ_20YY_Q#
- Verluste+Y KompWV_KWXX_20YY_BaseY_20YY

Delivery takes place between [TT.MM.YYYY 00:00] and [TT.MM.YYYY 00:00 + 1 Month / Quarter / Year]. The quarters start on the first of January, April, July and October.

2 Tender conditions

The bidder agrees to the following tender conditions:

- In order to participate in the tender, the bidder should sign the «Framework Agreement governing the supply and purchase of energy for the compensation of active power losses» with Swissgrid, which should be valid at the time of delivery.
- The bidder shall set a price (in EUR per MWh) for each submitted offer. The number of offers that a bidder can submit is not limited. No conditional offers are allowed.
- Each bidder is allowed to correct existing offers or add new offers until the end of the offer period. Each offer is binding independently of all others.
- Swissgrid will make the selection as follows: First, the offers will be ranked according to the price. Swissgrid will consider the offers in ascending order of the indicated price. In the case of offers with the same price, priority will be given to those which were received first. If an offer has been corrected, then the time of correction will be considered as the time of receipt.
- Offers shall be binding for both parties; even a bidder whose offer is ultimately not accepted (and therefore the supply contract with Swissgrid is not effective) shall be released from his obligation of his offers once he is informed from Swissgrid about the results of the call for tender.
- In the event of a bid being accepted, the supply contract shall come into effect upon Swissgrid's acceptance of the offer submitted by the bidder.
- Swissgrid reserves the right to unilaterally suspend a call for tender without prior notice and without accepting one or more offers.
- Remuneration is based on the respective offer price and is governed by the framework agreement. Any grid usage fees shall be borne exclusively by the bidder and shall be taken into account in the bidder's offer price.
